SUMMARY OF TRENDS IN FEMALE OFFENDERS

There were 296 more female new court commitments in FY2015 than there were in FY2011. Although the total number of female new court commitments (NCC) considered "violent" under §17.1-805 of the *Code of Virginia* has risen each of the past four years, the average sentence length for these female offenders during this time is at its shortest.

The female SR Confined population is growing. There were almost 500 more female offenders confined at the end of FY2015 as there were at the end of FY2011, an increase of nearly 18%. The female SR Confined population is also older, on average. While offenders aged 50 and older represented 10% of the female SR confined population in FY2011, they make up nearly 16% of this group in FY2015. There were over 200 more SR Confined female offenders with a Most Serious Offense (MSO) of Drug Sales in FY2015 than there were in FY2011.

The female SR Release population is growing as well. There were 236 more female offenders released from an SR term of incarceration in FY2015 than there were in FY2011, representing an increase of 17%. The number of female SR Releases with a violent or drug DOC crime type has increased substantially since FY2011, especially those with an MSO of Assault or Drug Sales.
